The College of Charleston's Distinguished Adjunct Faculty Teaching Award was established in 2014 and honors those adjunct faculty members who are outstanding among the College's many exceptional teachers. This year's award recipient is Thomas R. Martin from the Department of Communication.

Tom joined the Communication department in 2007 as an adjunct faculty member and the department's first Executive in Residence, having previously worked as Senior Vice President and Director of Corporate Relations at ITT Corporation and as the Vice President of Corporate Communications for FedEx.
