Scott Peeples received his PhD in English from Louisiana State University in 1994. In his seventeen years at the College of Charleston, he has taught twenty different courses, specializing in antebellum American literature. From 1999 to 2006 he coordinated the American Studies program; he is currently Associate Chair of the English Department.

Prof. Peeples' publications include two books, *Edgar Allan Poe Revisited* (1998) and *The Afterlife of Edgar Allan Poe* (2004), which won the Patrick F. Quinn Award for the year's outstanding book on Poe, as well as numerous articles in academic journals and anthologies. He co-edits the journal *Poe Studies: History, Theory, Interpretation*, and from 2005 to 2011 he edited the book series *Literary Criticism in Perspective* for Camden House Press. In 2009, he was awarded a Fulbright Specialist grant to present lectures and workshops on Poe in Russia.
