

## Salary Increases for Tenure, Promotions, and Post-Tenure Review

The following salary increases<sup>1</sup> have been approved for tenure, faculty promotions, Senior Instructor renewals, and post-tenure review and are subject to the terms, performance expectations, and review processes outlined in the *Faculty/Administration Manual*.

## **Instructor and Senior Instructor Faculty**
